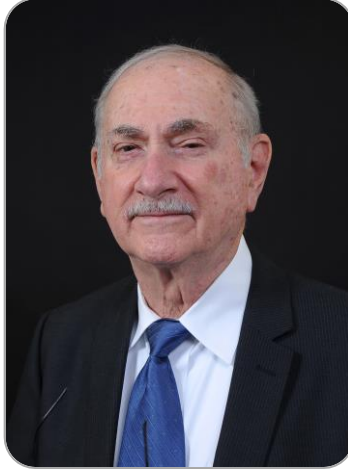


Biography
